

UCAS Timeline 2016/17

September 2016		
15th October 2016, 1800	•	Deadline for Oxford, Cambridge, Medicine, Dentistry and Vet Science applications.
November Half Term		INTERNAL deadline for Personal Statements and Tutor references
15th January 2017, 1800		Deadline for school and college applications for all other courses except some Art and Design. (Applications received after this date will be classed as late by UCAS and do not have to be considered by Universities).
February		Application cycle normally opens for student finance. Check www.slc.co.uk/england website for the exact date. Apply as soon as you can, you do not need to wait for offers.
20th February		UCAS Extra opens. Extra allows you to make further applications, one application at a time, if you have either been rejected by all your offers, or you reject all your offers.
24th March		Deadline for art and design applications exempt from the 15th January deadline.
31st March	•	Initial deadline for universities and colleges to reply back with offers to students who have applied by the 15th January (but they can take longer).
8th May		If all your offers have been given to you by the 31st March you have until today to reply back, (unless applying through Extra). If you don't UCAS will decline all your offers on your behalf.
9th May		Universities and colleges <u>must</u> reply back with offers by this date, if you applied by the 15th January, otherwise UCAS will decline the offers from those institutions that do not reply.
31st May	-	Application deadline for Student Finance England to guarantee you have your funding in place for when you start your course. (The later you leave it after this date, the less chance there is of having funding in place for when you start)
6th June		You must reply to all offers made by universities and colleges who gave offers by the 9th May. If you don't UCAS will decline all your offers on your behalf.
30th June		Absolute deadline for applications through the normal UCAS route. Applications received after this date will go into Clearing.
3rd July	←	Last day to apply through UCAS Extra.
17th August 2017		A Level and Advanced Diploma results day. The full Clearing vacancy lists are published and Adjustment opens. Clearing is for those students who have not done as well as they expected and they have been rejected by their 'firm' and 'insurance' places. Adjustment is for those students who have done much better than expected and exceeded their predicted grades. More detailed information on both can be found on the UCAS Website, www.ucas.com.
