## Guidance notes

**Registration** - 9am to 9:15am to allow for us to make the draw and start play promptly at 9:30am

**Briefing** - 9:25am - **All** players and parents are expected to attend this in the parents' room.

**Clocks** will be used. Time control - 25 minutes for each player for whole game

**Round time starts:**

Round 1 - 9:30

Round 2 - 10:30

Round 3 - 11:30

Round 4 - 13:00

Round 5 - 14:00

Round 6 - 15:00

Presentation - ~16:00

- The aim is for there to be two sections, one for under-13 and one for under-18. Players must play in their age section. If there are insufficient numbers to run two sections then all players will be in one section. However there will be prizes for the top scoring U-13, 2nd and 3rd and the same for the top scoring U-18, 2nd and 3rd.
- In case of players being on equal scores for prizes the tie breaks will be:
  1. Result of head to head if they played each other during the tournament.
  2. Sum of progressive score
  3. 10 minute play-off (draw for colours)
  4. Repeat of 3 (with colours reversed)
  5. Armageddon - 5 minutes for white, 4 minutes for black, both with 2 second increments per move. A draw counts as a win for black. (draw for colours)
- Notation - Players are not required to write down their moves. However some notation sheets will be available if players wish to write down their moves.
- **Parents/carers/coaches etc - Are not allowed in the playing room during play (unless specifically requested by the event organiser) nor watching through the door or windows. It is distracting to your child and, more importantly, distracting to other players. Such behaviour will result in a default, there will be no warning, this is your warning. 'Camping out' immediately outside the playing room is similarly unacceptable.**
- If parents/carers need to speak to the organisers can this please be done between rounds. If it is urgent and during play then speak to the tournament representative in the parents room and they will get our attention.
- Players - If there is a problem/query during the game please raise your hand and one of the organisers will come over and help all we can. Please do not leave it until after the game as we would be limited then as to what we can do.
- We can only accept responsibility for the children while in the playing room. Outside the playing room they are the responsibility of their parent(s) carer(s).
- Please treat the school and surrounding area with respect. Park responsibly. Please tidy up after you.
- Please no food in the playing room.
- **For parents/carers/siblings who do not wish to remain in the playing venue all day there are plenty of places to visit nearby. The Usher Gallery, various parks, Lincoln Cathedral and the Lincoln City Centre shops are all within easy walking distance.**
